CREEPY COMIC COSTUME

You really like to put on a horrible mask, and then jump out and shout, “BOO!” But when you do, your little brother lets out this horrible high screech that makes all the adults crazy. Can you design a costume that is both scary and silly, something that everyone will like?

Challenge: Create a Halloween costume that is both frightening and funny.

Time: Part One: You will build a costume for yourself. It should include both spooky and humorous elements.

Part Two: You will have 2 minutes to demonstrate the scary and comic aspects of your costume to the appraisers. Your presentation can take any form (an ad, singing, dancing, rhyme, etc.).

Materials to use:

1 roll of toilet paper

1 garbage bag

1 roll of duct tape

1 pair of scissors and markers (may not be included in the solution)

4 sheets of typing paper

1 square foot of aluminum foil

Scoring:

Up to 30 points for the scary part of the costume

Up to 30 points for the funny part of the costume

Up to 20 points for the creative use of materials

Up to 20 points for a positive attitude for your performance
